Lamaro's occupies an enviable position opposite Howe Crescent Park in Melbourne's leafy inner suburb of South Melbourne. From a very rundown and claustrophobic interior the brief was to transform the Bayview Hotel into a preeminent and up-market Gastro-pub with sufficient quality in its offer to attract the local business community and private patrons who were looking for more than the typical clinical fitout that pervades inner city venues.

The resulting interiors are a rich tapestry of spaces and finishes offering a 80 seat restaurant, conservatory, wine rooms, cocktail bar with executive-let apartments above.

The 1930's façade has been sensitively renovated to heritage requirements and marks the perfect frame for the sympathetic interiors beyond.
